The North Carolina Superfund Section received your letter of 8 May 1991 concerning decontamination of heavy equipment used in the Site Investigations to be conducted at USMC Camp Lejeune. The North Carolina Superfund Section concurs with the procedure outlined in this letter in which any potential gross contamination will be removed on site followed by final decontamination on vehicle washracks. It should be understood, however, that if future sampling in these washrack areas or any other areas reveal the presence of contamination, these areas may require additional monitoring and/or remediation.
