The North Carolina Superfund Section has received and reviewed your letter of 8 May 1991 and the subject documents. With one exception, the comments presented in our letter of 18 March 1991, and concerns expressed during the Technical Review Committee meeting of 21 March 1991, appear to have been adequately addressed in the revised subject documents. The one exception concerns the use of air purifying respirator (APR's) discussed on page 5-1 and 5-2 of the Draft Final Health and Safety Plan. A number of the sites addressed by this document are old dump sites; therefore, the specific contaminants that may be encountered cannot be identified prior to the Remedial Investigation. Since the cartridges used with APR's must be matched to specific contaminants, the use of APR's at sites involving a potentially wide variety of unknown contaminants is very risky. It is therefore recommended that Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) be utilized instead of APR's.
