
- The site location for the 8th Engineer Battalion Communications Shop (Site B) for the subject project has been identified as an area adjacent to a known contamination site. The groundwater samples indicate the contamination extends to monitoring well 1GW6 which is in the opposite direction of natural drainage from the known site. Enclosure (1) outlines and further describes the potential problems with this site.
- The reference was secured prior to the publication of the known contamination site information.
- Predesign meetings are scheduled to commence on this project on 18 June 1991. It is requested that a meeting be conducted on 13 June 1991 at 1330 in the Public Works Conference Room to discuss the impact of developing the selected site. Additionally, discussion should be held to determine procedures for involving IR review/comments on all future project site approvals. *(Environmental Impact Review Working Group) is the mechanism*
