1. At the conclusion of reference (a) I asked about guidance for handling the subject situation at Lot 203 which EPA/State representatives and Mr. R. E. Alexander visited on 12 Jan 89.

2. EPA recommended only the five drums and soil excavated be containerized and prepared for disposal. Lot 203 is scheduled for study and appropriate action under the Base Installation Restoration program and should continue to be handled accordingly. NREAD will pursue disposal alternatives for the five drums and soil and discuss with AC/S, Facilities before proceeding.

3. During reference (b), Mr. Brinson advised Mr. Joe Pallotti, retired DRMO Civil Service employee, was contacted 11 Jan 89 and would visit the Base DRMO 13 Jan 89 to show where items had been buried at Lot 203 and tell what he knew about the buried items.
