
Baker has identified four additional information requests pertaining to the evaluation of the feasibility of using the HPIA STP to treat contaminated groundwater from HPIA. This information is in addition to the items identified in the letter telefaxed to you earlier today.

1. The total average air flow rate for all of the aerators in the lagoon. If this information is not available, the equipment specifications for each of the aerators will be sufficient.
2. The sludge withdraw rate from the primary clarifier (following the aerated lagoon).
3. The percent solid value of the sludge mentioned above.
4. The measured daily flow rate for the days of the three-day sampling event. Although exact dates have not been established, it is anticipated that sampling will be conducted the week of February 3, 1992.
