Dear Ms. Barnett:

Pursuant to our telephone conversation, I am writing to confirm your agreement to an extension of the response date for ARAR's associated with the Remedial Investigation /Feasibility Study, Hadnot Point area of Camp Lejeune MCB, from 15 July 1987 to 22 July 1987.

Inasmuch as the request for ARAR's for a remediation at the Hadnot Point site is the first such request we have received, our intent is to provide your office with not only numbers but the philosophy and methods used to determine those numbers. Under the provisions of the North Carolina groundwater classifications and quality standards, administrative code 15NCAC 2L, "synthetic, man-made or other substances that do not naturally occur," are prohibited in groundwaters. In other words, we have a zero concentration standard. Since such a standard is not readily enforceable, health based target concentrations for remedial actions, have been established on a site specific basis within North Carolina. We are, therefore, processing the request for ARAR's for the Hadnot Point site in the same manner. Dr. Ted Taylor, a toxicologist with the Epidemiology Section of the Department of Human Resources, is preparing an evaluation of the health risk associated with the compounds listed in Mr. J.R. Bailey's request. Dr. Taylor advises us that his evaluation will be completed in sufficient time to meet the requested 22 July 1987 response date.


