**Comments concerning the Draft Remedial Investigation/Feasibility  
Study Health and Safety Plan  
Operable Unit No. 13**

1. Page 3-6, section 3.5.2: According to Camp Lejeune's Fish and Wildlife Division, the coral snake also exists in southeastern North Carolina. This venomous snake should be mentioned in addition to the pit vipers.
2. Page 4-1, section 4.3: Ensure that a "safety zone" boundary, surrounding a given drilling operation is established and delineated with flagging tape or cones.
