The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the above subject document. The pentachlorophenol (PCP), detected in the groundwater sample, raises a question of concern. PCP is a compound that is usually detected as soil contamination and it is not typically found in groundwater. It is the Agency's recommendation that additional groundwater samples be taken around the detected area to confirm/deny a source area.
