We reviewed of these documents and submit the following comments:

1. The groundwater exceeds the North Carolina groundwater standards; a plan for the groundwater remediation needs to be developed. Depending on site-specific conditions, monitored natural attenuation with institutional controls may be appropriate.
2. The clean up goals in the Remedial Work Plan should be changed to match the clean up goals in the Action Memorandum and the EE/CA.
3. Attached are Dave Lilley's comments on the BRA in the EE/CA and the Final Pre-Remedial Investigation Screening Study.
