Dear Mr. Wooten:

The North Carolina Superfund Section has received and reviewed the Draft Site Management Plan for the subject site. Our office has also received and reviewed EPA's draft comments on this document. The following comments are offered to supplement comments made by EPA.

1. As discussed during the last meeting of the Technical Review Committee (TRC) on 21 March 1991, two ponds that have been stocked and are available for recreational fishing are present on Site #65, Engineer Dump Area (see page 27 of the transcript of the TRC meeting). If the surface water and sediment sampling listed in the scope of work on page 5-23 of the subject document reveals the presence of contamination, then tissue from fish in these ponds should be analyzed to insure protection of the public health.
2. In Table 2-2 on pages 2-5 and 2-6 of the subject document, it is indicated that a groundwater contamination potential exists at Site 3, Old Creosote Plant, and Site 80, Paradise Point (Golf Course Pesticide Area). On page 2-21 of

the subject document, an area of dead and/or dying vegetation on Site 80 is also discussed. It is therefore recommended that groundwater monitoring be added to the Scope of Work presented on page 5-4 for Site 3 and on page 5-31 for Site 80.
