Re: Government Review Comments of ESE Installation
Restoration Program Documents at Marine Corps Base,
Camp Lejeune

Dear Ms. Sayres:

This letter forwards the Government review comments of the June 1990 draft documents prepared by ESE for Remedial Investigation/Feasibility Study (RI/FS) at Hadnot Point Industrial Area and limited Scope Investigations at Sites 6, 48, and 69. The documents reviewed are the Site Summary Report, Sampling Plan, Work Plan, Health and Safety Plan, and Community Relations Plan.

The following comments apply:

a. Revise documents to incorporate our response to the EPA Region IV comments [enclosure (1)].

b. Health and Safety Plan.

(1) Correct the phone number for the Poison Control Center at Duke University (1-800-672-1697).

(2) Section 8.2.2 (pg. 25) states that an HNU with a 11.2 eV lamp will be used to monitor air. The HNU is available with a 10.2 or 11.7 eV lamp, not a 11.2 eV lamp. Correct this.

(3) The arrows on the emergency route to the hospital map are time-consuming to locate. Highlight this route (e.g. colored marker, bold line).

(4) Section 7.1 (pg. 22) states that advanced training will be provided to any personnel required to wear Level A protection. Briefly clarify the meaning of "advanced training," i.e., training to familiarize worker with restrictions of Level A protection, training required to use an SCBA, etc. If this "advanced training" refers to training required to use a SCBA, revise this statement to include Level B as well as Level A protection.

(5) Incorporate enclosures (2) and (3) comments. (Please return enclosure (2) along with the Final Draft documents.)

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c. Community Relations Plan.

(1) In Section 3.3.3 (pg. 21), input the two Information Repositories established at/near Camp Lejeune. These are the "MCB Camp Lejeune Installation Restoration Office," and the "Onslow County Health Department."

(2) In the list of Acronyms and on page 4, correct reference to NCDEHNR (North Carolina Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources).

(3) Incorporate enclosure (4) comments.

As previously discussed, please submit "Draft Final" revised documents by 24 September 1990.
