The enclosed two copies of the Draft Site Management Plan for Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, are submitted as required by the Federal Facility Agreement (FFA). This primary document is due 30 days from the FFA effective date of March 1, 1991.

On March 8, 1991, Mr. Michael Hartnett, EPA Region IV, concurred with a request by the Atlantic Division, Naval Facilities Engineering Command to exclude underground storage tank sites from the draft site management plan. Accordingly, sites 45 and 52 have not been included in the enclosure and will be monitored by the North Carolina Department of Environment, Health and Natural Resources.


