

EPA is in receipt of the documents titled "Final Remedial Investigation Report for Hadnot Point Industrial Area Operable Unit Shallow Soils and Castle Hayne Aquifer" and "Baseline Risk Assessment for Hadnot Point Industrial Area Operable Unit Shallow Soils and Castle Hayne Aquifer". This letter serves as clarification of EPA's position with regard to these two documents. As expressed in my letter dated January 28, 1992, these documents are "interim" and are not comprehensive enough to support the required decision documents. In light of this, EPA accepts these documents as "background" to be used as reference materials when reviewing the comprehensive work plan due to EPA in September 1992 to address the entire Hadnot Point Industrial Area.
