This letter provides you with the EPA's comments on the Draft Final Interim Record of Decision for the Shallow Aquifer at the Hadnot Point Industrial Area Operable Unit dated August 11, 1992. EPA's comments are minimal on the draft final document. They are as follows:

1. Declaration - EPA does not intend to sign the Record of Decision. A concurrence letter will be forwarded to the Navy upon notification the document has been signed by the Commanding General.
2. Page 5, 2nd paragraph - I believe the reference here is to "ambient" water quality criteria.
3. Page 20, top of page, 2nd line - "Total volume of the contaminants in the aquifer will be reduced...".

EPA trusts that these minor changes will be incorporated into the Final document.
