The referenced document has been received and reviewed by this office. The following comments are offered by the North Carolina Superfund Section. Note that we are still reviewing the full RI/FS Work Plans for OU 10. The review of those documents should be completed before the end of September.

1. General

It was not completely clear from the document how this Interim RI/FS will fit in with the full RI/FS for the remainder of Operable Unit 10.

2. Page 3-3, Section 3.3⁴

This section on Field Investigations indicates that the samples will be analyzed as Level III data instead of Level IV data. It would seem more appropriate to treat these samples as Level IV data.

3. Page 3-3, Section 3.5

It is not clear if the reference to the RI/FS is intended to be the interim or full RI/FS.

4. Page 7-1, Section 7.1

This section indicates that these samples will be analyzed as Level II data. It seems more appropriate to treat these samples as Level III or IV data.
