The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region IV has reviewed the above subject decision document and concurs with the selected remedy for the Remedial Action at Sites 21, 24 & 78. This remedy is supported by the previously completed Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Study and Baseline Risk Assessment Reports.

The selected remedy is a combination of source control (interim remedial action treatment system extension) and off site soil disposal. This remedial action is protective of human health and the environment, complies with Federal and State requirements that are legally applicable or relevant and appropriate to the remedial action and is cost effective.
