**COMMENTS CONCERNING THE INTERIM PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN FOR SURFICIAL GROUNDWATER, OPERABLE UNIT 10, SITE 35**

1. Page 2, para 2 - Remove the reference to Onslow County in the first sentence.
2. Page 4, para 1 - The last sentence indicates a four lane divided highway; this should be corrected to read a six lane divided highway.
3. Page 15, para 2; and page 17, para 2; and page 18, para 3 - Access to the Brinson Creek side of the highway has yet to be determined. ✓ has
4. Page 20, para 6 - The first sentence refers to a public comment period that will begin on July 26, 1994, and end on August 26, 1994. This should read 1995.
5. Page 20, para 6 - The first sentence should read Interim Proposed Remedial Action Plan.
6. Table 1 (Continued) - The category of Evaluation Criteria, Requirements for Agency Coordination for RAA3, RAA4, and RAA5, indicates the requirement to obtain a "special permit to perform construction in wetlands", as well as "air and water discharge." Under the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act, permits are not required but the intent of the permit must be met.
