MEDICAL REVIEW OF (DRAFT) TREATABILITY STUDY WORK PLAN

Ref: (a) Guidance for Conducting Remedial Investigations and Feasibility Studies Under CERCLA, October 1988 (EPA/540/G-89/004)

General Comments:

1. The draft document entitled "Treatability Study Work Plan Operable Unit No. 14 (Site 69) Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune North Carolina," dated April 1995 was provided to the Navy Environmental Health Center for review. The report was prepared for LANTNAVFACENCOM by Baker Environmental, Inc.
2. A health and safety plan was not included in the document.

Review Comment and Recommendation:

1. Page 1-2, Section 1.1, Purpose and Organization

Comment: The text states "All on-site work will be performed in accordance with the site-specific Health and Safety Plan (HASP) prepared by SBP under separate cover." The introduction to Appendix D, (SBP Standard Operating Procedures) states "The SOPs are intended to augment the text of the report to which it is appended and the project-specific health and safety and quality assurance plans as appropriate." Reference (a) Section 5.5.2 states "Health and safety concerns are more critical during pilot tests because larger amounts of waste are involved and equipment is more complex." Therefore, we feel that the site-specific HASP should be included as an attachment to the SOP contained in Appendix D in order that the document may be used as a stand-alone reference.

Recommendation: A HASP should be included in Appendix D so that it may be used as a site-specific stand-alone document.
