Comments concerning the Interim Record of Decision for Surficial Groundwater for a Portion of Operable Unit No. 10, Site 35 - Camp Geiger Area Fuel Farm, Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina

1. Page iv, List of Acronyms and Abbreviations, NCP stands for National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan.
2. Page iv, Description of Selected Alternative, provide a schematic indicating the different stages of the selected alternative.
3. Page 2, Site History and Enforcement Activities, states that plans are currently being prepared to empty, clean, dismantle, and remove the ASTs. Demolition of the ASTs is currently underway.
4. Page 14, 7.0 Description of Alternatives, states that an access road running parallel to the east side of the highway from the south will be developed. Is the cost for this road included in the selected alternative?
5. Page 29, Background on Community Involvement, states that there is a transcript for the public meeting on May 10, 1995. This transcript is not available.
6. Figure 1, Camp Lejeune and Site 35 Location Map, indicates that Camp Geiger is a Tent Camp. Delete the designation, (Tent Camp) from this figure.
