The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has completed its review of the above subject document.

There is one area that needs to be clarified. The text states "remediation levels were developed based on the current civilian adult worker scenario and an action level of  $1 \times 10^{-6}$ ", however, the remediation levels listed in the tables are the residential scenarios. Also, the  $1 \times 10^{-6}$  level is a **risk level** not an **action level**. This area needs to be clarified.
