Dear Mr. Watters:

The former "Camp Geiger Dump", aboard Marine Corps Base, Camp Geiger is designated as Installation Restoration (IR) Site 41. From 1946 to 1970, this area was utilized as a dumping facility which received construction debris, petroleum waste, pesticides, solvents, batteries, chemical warfare agents, and ordnance. Although much of this material was burned prior to disposal, buried, chemical warfare material (CWM) and unexploded ordnance (UXO) may exist within the site. While field analyses revealed no CWM or UXO within Site 41, on-site investigations were limited due to potential safety issues.

Although the presence of CWM and UXO cannot be confirmed, we propose that this area be restricted to all personnel to ensure public safety. Our plan is to post signs every 200 feet around the site and chain the roadways leading into the site (enclosure (1)). This work will be completed by the remediation contractor.


