## ATSDR ACTIVITY REPORT

1. The following information is taken verbatim from the Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (ATSDR) third quarter FY-1995 activity report for Department of the Navy installations.

Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, NC

The study of adverse pregnancy outcomes among women exposed to volatile organic compounds (VOCs) is ongoing. Data from housing records have been computerized and the sample has been selected for the medical record pilot study. Birth records and housing records have been computerized. Work to match birth and housing records will continue in the fourth quarter.
