COMMENTS CONCERNING THE DRAFT FINAL INTERIM FEASIBILITY STUDY
OPERABLE UNIT NO. 10 SITE 35 - CAMP GEIGER AREA FUEL FARM, MARINE

1. Page ES-1, para 3 - Change the second sentence to read: "The main entrance is located along U.S. Route 17, approximately 3.5 miles southwest of the City of Jacksonville."

2. Table 3-2 - Change the sentence corresponding to the No Action/General Response Action, Site-Specific Applicability to: "Potentially applicable to any site; the NCP requires a 'no action' process option."

3. Table 3-2 - Change the sentence corresponding to the Discharge Actions/General Response Action, Surface Water/Process Option, Description to: "Treated water discharged to Brinson Creek." The unnamed tributary and Tank Creek are located at IR Site #41.
