COMMENTS CONCERNING THE DRAFT FINAL INTERIM PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN FOR SURFICIAL GROUNDWATER OPERABLE UNIT NO. 10, SITE 35 - CAMP GEIGER AREA FUEL FARM, MARINE CORPS BASE, CAMP LEJEUNE, NORTH CAROLINA

1. Page 2, para 2 - Change the second sentence to read: "The main entrance to Camp Geiger is off U.S. Route 17, approximately 3.5 miles southwest of the City of Jacksonville."
2. Page 2, para 3 - Change the number of Operable Units at MCB, Camp Lejeune from 13 to 14.
3. Page 21 - The room number for the Information Repository at MCB, Camp Lejeune should be changed from Room 237 to Room 238.
