Dear Ms. Landman:

The NC Superfund Section has completed its review of the Record of Decision for Operable Unit 4 and concurs with the selected remedy. Note that concurrence by the State is contingent upon the following conditions.

1. Successful completion of the following State regulatory actions:
  - a.) Reclassification of the aquifer under Site 41 as either "RS" (Restricted Designation) or "GC" (source of water supply for purposes other than drinking water).
  - b.) Receipt of a variance from the State Surface Water Quality Standards (in accordance with 15A NCAC 2B.0218) to address the contamination seen in the unnamed tributary on Site 41.
2. This concurrence is based on the information presented in the Record of Decision, Remedial Investigation Report, Feasibility Study and the Proposed Remedial Action Plan. Should the State receive new or additional information which significantly affects this concurrence, it may be modified or withdrawn with appropriate written notice to the Navy and EPA Region IV.

The State reserves the right to review, comment, and make independent assessments of all future work relating to the site.
