This submittal incorporates revisions based on comments received from USEPA Region IV, the Activity, and NC DEHNR on the draft PRAP. Responses to these comments were forwarded to LANTDIV on July 24, 1996.

Two copies of the PRAP have been forwarded to the Activity (Mr. Neal Paul). One copy has been forwarded to USEPA Region IV, representatives from NC DEHNR, OHM Corporation, NEHC, ATSDR, and RAB members.

This document is being submitted in accordance with the date presented in the modification letter dated September 24, 1996. Concurrence on this modification was received from LANTDIV on September 30, 1996.

Comments on the proposed remedial action will be addressed during the public meeting scheduled to be held on February 5, 1997 in Jacksonville, North Carolina. An additional thirty day public comment period will follow the Public Meeting date. A summary of all comments and responses pertaining to the PRAP will be provided in the Responsive Summary in the Final Record of Decision.


