- e. Site Summary Reports for the above


To assist you in the discussions, reports on the sites are enclosed for your review, familiarization, and comment.

Subj: TECHNICAL REVIEW COMMITTEE (TRC) FOR THE INSTALLATION  
RESTORATION PROGRAM (IRP)

Situation: To develop an appropriate and meaningful TRC for Camp  
Lejeune's IRP

Discussion: The purpose of the TRC is to review, comment, and  
guide IRP actions at a federal installation. Where this purpose  
is being accomplished, the resulting IRP work has proved to yield  
coordinated, informed, successful remediated actions for all  
parties concerned. Parties concerned are the EPA, State, County,  
City, and federal installations, and a vital part of the IRP is  
involving all these parties in open dialogue.

The TRC will meet at least twice a year and/or as scheduled by  
the Chairman, review and comment on documents and the program's  
progress, and then give broad direction for continued work. An  
important aspect of the TRC will be identifying federal and  
state regulations, standards, requirements, criteria or  
limitations that are legally applicable or relevant and  
appropriate under the circumstances of the release or threatened  
release of a hazardous substance, pollutant or contaminant at the  
installation. The TRC can also foster cooperation with regulatory  
agencies to facilitate the IRP's forward movement in a smooth and  
quick fashion devoid of notices of violations (NOV's). The  
importance of the TRC cannot be overstated.
