Comments submitted by LANTDIV (Ms. Laurie Boucher) and the Navy Environmental Health Center have been addressed. The Work Plan and Health and Safety Plan have been revised to reflect these comments. Copies of the RI/FS Work Plan have been forwarded to Mr. Carl Froede (EPA Region IV), Mr. Jack Butler (N.C. DEHNR), and members of the technical review committee via registered first class mail.

I will be forwarding to you the Draft Sampling and Analysis Plan the week of December 1. Copies of this plan will also be forwarded to those individuals mentioned above. In addition, copies of the RI/FS Work Plan and SAP will be forwarded to Ms. Marilew Bartling (Martin Marietta).

Please note that we have discussed and agreed upon changing the planned submittal date for this deliverable in order to rescope the field investigations at Site 6 (Lot 201) and Site 69. Rescoping of these investigations was necessary based on new information received concerning Site 6, and recommendations and input received by the U.S. Army (chemical surety investigative procedures for Site 69). The revised planned submittal date for the RI/FS Work Plan is December 1, 1991 (formally November 22, 1991). I will have Baker's Contract Administrator (Ms. Suzanne Thomas) prepare a formal notification letter to Mr. Dean Koepp (LANTDIV) in order to document this change in schedule.


