Re: Interim Remedial Action Report Guidelines

Dear Mr. Froede:

As discussed in our meeting of April 18, 1991, and in subsequent telephone calls, we requested written guidance outlining reporting requirements for interim remedial actions. This information is necessary to move forward with planning and conducting an interim remedial action for the Hadnot Point Industrial Area (HPIA) shallow aguifer at MCB Camp Lejeune.

In the last several weeks, all interested parties have been discussing plans to conduct an interim remedial action at HPIA shallow aquifer. The intent of this action is to prevent the further migration of contaminants while a final remedial action is being developed for various operable units at HPIA.

The National Contingency Plan (NCP) defines specific reporting requirements for Remedial Investigations, Feasibility Studies, Proposed Remedial Action Plans, and Records of Decision. The NCP does not, however, address the reporting requirements for interim remedial actions.

In several recent discussions, you have indicated to us and MCB Camp Lejeune that the reporting requirements as defined in the NCP are to be modified for interim actions. We have received from you via facsimile a <u>draft</u> outline of these modified reporting guidelines. However, these are not considered final and are thus subject to change.

Awaiting your final guidance, we will proceed as scheduled in our Site Management Plan for the Interim Remedial Action at HPIA. We will prepare appropriate reports on the planned interim action based on the reporting requirements outlined in your facsimile of April 19, 1991. Any significant changes to this draft guidance may delay submittal of the appropriate reports. Re: Interim Remedial Action Report Guidelines
